Miss OLP Ball 2010

General Information

The Miss OLP Ball is the Academy's winter formal which the students and their escorts (high school students or older) are invited to attend. Students from the Academy may also choose to attend the Ball without an escort. The Ball will be held on Saturday, February 6, 2010 at the Westin Horton Plaza. It will be held from 8:00 pm-11 pm. Students must arrive at the dance no later than 8:30 pm. There will be no exceptions. Please make all transportation and dinner plans to accommodate arriving on time for the Ball. If you arrive after 8pm, parents will be notified, and you will be subject to disciplinary action. Students may leave the Ball no earlier than 10:30pm. Students must be picked up within 15 minutes after the dance which ends at 11:00 pm. There will be no exceptions. There will be serious disciplinary action for any student who is not picked up promptly at the conclusion of the Ball.

STUDENTS ATTENDING THE MISS OLP BALL MUST ATTEND A FULL DAY OF SCHOOL ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2010. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

Students attending the dance are advised to not leave personal items unattended. The Academy of Our Lady of Peace is not responsible for the loss of personal items such as purses, cameras, phones, jackets, or wraps.

Photographs

Pictures at the dance will be taken by Reyman Photography and are available for all students to purchase. The pictures will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. Price list order forms will be given to the students at the time they buy their bids. These forms should be filled out prior to the dance. Both cash and checks will be accepted. Please make checks out to "Reyman Photography."

Dance/Event Pass

A dance/event pass must be completed by all AOLP students before the bid to the dance can be purchased. The form should be read and filled out carefully by the students, their escorts and their parents. The Director of Student Services, Mrs. Jeanette Handelsman must approve the forms by Tuesday, February 2., 2010. Completed forms must be presented when buying a bid for the Ball. Bids

Bids will be sold by the Executive Council beginning Monday, December 7, 2009. The final day to purchase a bid is Friday, January 29, 2010. The price of the bid is \$75.00 per couple or \$40.00 per single. The prices for bids sold Monday, February 1-Wednesday, February 3, 2010 is \$80.00 for a couple and \$45.00 for a single. If paying with cash, only exact change will be accepted. If paying by check make checks payable to "OLP." A completed and signed dance/event pass must be presented when purchasing a bid. Payment for the Miss OLP Dance bid must accompany the completed and signed Dance Pass, placed in the Bid Payment Envelopes (found on Activity Board outside Mrs. Handelsman's office) and put through the slot on Mrs. Handelsman's office door. If a student is unable to attend the dance and has purchased a bid, she must notify the Director of Student Services by Thursday, January 29 or a 50% penalty will be charged.

Attire

The Miss OLP Ball is a special event that calls for semi-formal attire. Girls wear elegant dresses/party dresses. No bare midriffs are allowed. Dresses may be no shorter than the middle of the thigh and no backless, low-cut or otherwise revealing dresses may be worn. Gentlemen are required to wear a suit, sport coat, or sweater and tie. No tennis shoes are permitted. Anyone dressed inappropriately (which is determined at the discretion of the administration) will be denied admission without a refund and released to their parent/guardian.

Beverages

Complimentary juice and sodas will be available at the Dance.

Parking

Hotel valet parking is available for \$15.00. Self-parking is available at Horton Plaza for \$8.00/hour (3 hours free with validation with purchase. Validation machines, located in the central area of the Plaza, close at 9:00)

Because we want the evening to be enjoyable for everyone, we are reminding you of the responsibility for appropriate behavior. School policy, as well as the policy of the Westin Horton Plaza, dictates that individuals found to be or suspected of being under the influence of any drugs or alcohol will not be admitted into the Ball. Their parents will be notified and hotel security will hold them until their parents arrive. Under the school and hotel policy, no after hour parties will be allowed in the hotel.
