## COVID-19 Self-Screening Protocol

OLP plans to require individual health screenings that include temperature checks and self-reporting of specific COVID-19 questions prior to entering the OLP campus. Our main goal is to decrease the likelihood of virus transmission from symptomatic students and adults. In addition, it is the expectation that anyone who is feeling ill, remains at home.

We also will have a heightened expectation of students and adults to self-monitor themselves throughout the day. If a student or adult displays a temperature of greater than or equal to 100 degrees Fahrenheit OR symptoms of illness, they should immediately report to the health kiosk.

At the beginning of the day, in order to enter the OLP campus, all students and employees will need to complete a self-screening questionnaire available on an OLP app. This app will be accessible on any phone or electronic device. Students will then show successful completion of the self-screening app as they pass through one of the 4 designated entry points of the school:

- Green Gates off Oregon Street,
- Circle Drive Chapel Gates,
- Parking Structure Entry in front of St. Catherine's,
- Or the South Gate Pedestrian entry by Shiley Hall (off Collier Avenue)

Upon entering the grounds, all students and employees will have a passive temperature check and display their completed self-screening questionnaire. A sample of what the App may look like is included to the right.

The app will include three key components:

- COVID-19 symptoms reporting, exposure to someone with COVID-19
- Temperature self-reporting
- Digital badge clearance
